Be Mine

When you think about the month of February, what is the first thing that comes to mind? For many people the first response is Valentine's Day. The history of Valentine's Day goes back to an ancient Roman fertility celebration commemorated annually on February 15. Pope Gelasius I recast this pagan festival as a Christian feast day about 496 AD, declaring February 14 to be St. Valentine's Day. However, while there are a number of legends, exactly what this early pope intended to honor is not clear.

It was not until the 14th century that this Christian feast day became definitively associated with love. According to UCLA medieval scholar Henry Ansgar Kelly, author of *Chaucer and the Cult of Saint Valentine*, it was [Chaucer](#) who first linked St. Valentine's Day with romance in a poem written in 1381. Over the centuries, the holiday has evolved into a major commercialized gift and card giving event. In 1969, the Catholic Church revised its liturgical calendar, removing the feast days of saints whose historical origins were questionable. St. Valentine was one of the casualties. While Valentine's Day is not a recognized feast day in our Lutheran tradition, it does continue to be a feast day for the Anglican Church. The liturgical rite for the Feast of St. Valentine includes the optional rite of a renewal of marriage vows. (https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Valentine's_Day) This leads me to wonder if instead of participating in the commercialized holiday, what if you would do something intentional to enrich and renew your relationships?

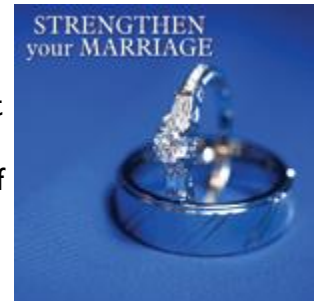
