



AFFIRMATION OF FAITH FOUNDATIONS

For 8th grade and older youth desiring to journey toward being confirmed / affirm their faith, please click here to access the 8 Foundations worksheets. Each worksheet has questions with scripture verses to answer

them with. The foundations worksheets are a condensed version of the catechism. Please schedule a 1-1 discipling session using this <u>link</u> after completing each worksheet. These 1-1s will provide you with an opportunity to share highlights from your learning, ask for clarification on questions that you could not answer (and it is anticipated you won't be able to answer all, so relax, it's about learning and growing through conversation!). Lastly, we will try praying aloud in the safety of the small group: pastor or Jenny, youth & parent or other mentor. Yes, we Lutherans need to learn to pray. In my experience, we are the most likely to be unable to pray in mixed groups!

Why this approach? Jesus said make disciples of all nations. Discipling is a relational process focused on building a living relationship with Jesus. A living relationship with Jesus includes interacting with Scripture on your own as well as in church and youth groups. It is important that your faith is a real part of your daily life so that it can help you cope during the trials of life. Like a driver's license, you need to know the facts about driving but you also need practice driving! Think of the foundations worksheets as your "Driver's Ed class" and your LIVE sessions on Wednesday night as your supervised driving hours, and your pre-confirmation/affirmation of faith session with Pastor Jeff when you are 16 or older, and feel ready, as your "Road Test". Just as the DMV issues Driver's Licenses when youth have both knowledge and road experience, so too it makes sense to issue Confirmation / Affirmation of Faith certificates when youth are prepared with both knowledge and LIVED experience:). We will provide a formal opportunity to be confirmed / affirm your faith each Spring for those that have completed foundations, built upon it through LIVE sessions, and convinced the pastor you have a living faith:) ... you can do this by showing initiative with action and involvement as well as the "Road Test" conversation!

By the way, anyone in church is welcome to try out the foundations worksheets to grow in faith! If you have specific questions, scheduling barriers, or unique circumstances, please reach out to pastor Jeff. We want to work with you as needed to support the primary goal of youth growing in faith! This model was developed in response to feedback about scheduling formal confirmation classes being near impossible these days. I get it, I hear you! The worksheets allow you to work your way through the content a little at a time in gaps during your busy week!




